INVESTMENT IN NEW DIESEL EQUIPMENT

Precision has recently bought a new common rail injector diesel test machine designed to test Bosch (automotive and commercial), Denso, Delphi and Siemens injectors. This allows us to offer a much greater service locally and builds on an


already strong and reliable diesel workshop.

We can now inspect, test and repair the majority of traditional and common rail injectors and fuel pumps.



NEW DYNAMOMETER ON ORDER

We soon hope to take delivery of an engine test dynamometer. A dynamometer or "dyno" for short is a device for measuring the force an engine can exert on a load cell. The power and torque produced by an engine, motor or other rotating prime mover can then be calculated at any given rotational speed (RPM).



This is a significant investment for Precision allowing us to continue offering our customers the best of service with upto-date testing facilities on site.

Precision are a Service Centre and UK Distributor for Pow-R-Quik, which predominantly manufacture parts for the off-shore oil and gas industry.



Due to the off-shore experience of both Andrew and John, we also carry out full skid refurbishment and the maintenance of off-shore kit.
